It's in the stillness of the ancient forests and the roar of the crystal-clear waterfalls, flowing down to the lush volcanic plains where food seems to grow before your eyes.

But it's the local makers and growers who harness this magic and bring the flavour of the Otways to life. Over the past 15 years, local producers have joined forces to literally put the region on the map.

It's called the Otway Harvest Trail, a locals' guide to eating, drinking, playing and staying in this unique corner of south-west Victoria just inland from the Great Ocean Road.


Our members are small-scale farmers, food and drink producers and like-minded neighbours in hospitality, accommodation and retail. We're united by our love for the Otways and have deep ties to the community. We also reckon our region has some of the world's best food, drink, flowers and fibre. Our main goal on the Otway Harvest Trail is to welcome visitors with a warm dose of country hospitality, sharing knowledge to help them explore every corner of the region. Our members also pitch in and support other businesses on the trail, following a set of values to keep our businesses sustainable through economic, social and environmental lenses.

If you're into small-batch artisan food, you've found your people. Our trail is peppered with cheesemakers, bakers, pasta makers, chocolatiers and makers of all sorts of delicacies, and there's always room for more.

We have farm gates, markets, wineries, breweries and distilleries, along with restaurants and cafes with menus chock full of local produce. Our farmers produce world-class dairy, beef and lamb, while fresh seafood is sourced from our coastal neighbours just down the road.

Our pick-your-own berries farms are legendary in the warmer months, and the sweet fruit is a perfect match for a bottle of local cider. Maybe you'd prefer a local wine or beer? There are plenty to choose from, along with local distilleries capturing the spirit of the region in every bottle of gin, vodka, brandy and whisky. We love it when visitors take their time, stopping for a chat as they wind their way through the Otways. We're always happy to share local intel, like the best place for coffee, the prettiest fern gully, that cool restaurant down a back road, and that place where you can spot a platypus in the wild. All that's left to do is book a place to stay the night. Or three.

WHAT THE SYMBOLS MEAN:



Long, warm days roll into spectacular sunsets and deliciously mild evenings, as the green foothills slowly change to a golden brown. You'll see farmers cutting and bailing hay into the night, some of them transforming their harvest into festive sculptures to see in the holidays. Potato farmers are also busy in the warmer months planting crops for the autumn harvest.

The buzz returns to our villages and towns as beach crowds seek respite in cool valleys or a quick dip in one of the chilly waterfalls.

Pick-your-own berry farms are bursting with ripe fruit and there's nothing better than taste testing a perfect sun-kissed raspberry before filling your bucket.

Vineyards are also lush and green, as new season grapes ripen in the sunshine in preparation for autumn's vintage.

Outdoor tables at pubs, cafes and restaurants are prime real estate. Summer is a wonderful time to explore the Otways, as the spring mud dries out to allow regular cars back on the windy bush tracks.

Visit the makers and growers along the way and find a shady spot for a picnic.





It's harvest time, so these are busy months for the makers and growers of the Otways Vineyards are a flurry of activity, as winemakers check the sugar levels of their grapes every day to achieve peak flavour.

Olives are also harvested and pressed into oil at this time of year to avoid the first frosts and heavy rains of winter. The grassy freshness of freshly pressed olive oil is nothing like older version on supermarket shelves.

For anyone growing fruit, it's a daily battle with cockatoos swooping in for a sweet treat. It's also the season for preserving the harvest in jams, chutneys, pickles and ferments. These jars and bottles and goodness are sold for the rest of the year at markets, shops and farms gates across the region.

Look out for wild apple trees on the side of the road – they're perfect for stewing. It's also flowering season for dahlias in March and April, and you can visit local farms with hundreds of varieties in bloom. Other farmers are busy harvesting potatoes and other root vegetables before the winter rains arrive. The volcanic dirt produces particularly delicious spuds.

For many Otway locals, autumn is a favourite time of year. There's still warmth in the sun, but the nights are crisp and cool. It's perfect weather for digging through second-hand shops and taking big walks in the bush.



Closed: Some public holidays As the days grow shorter, the smell of woodsmoke floats across the towns and villages as open fireplaces roar back to life. It might look quiet on the farms across the Otways, but makers and growers are busy preparing for the year ahead, ploughing winter crops and making repairs.

Locals running orchards and vineyards are barely recovered from their busy autumn harvest, but there's no time to rest when branches need pruning in readiness for new growth in spring. Winter is also a race against time at flower farms, where thousands of dahlia bulbs are dug up, divided and lovingly sold to flower lovers for replanting in summer.

It's hard to imagine endless fields of flowers in the thick of winter, but it's equally magical to wake to a sparkly frost or pea-soup fog. For most Otway locals, winter is a quieter, contemplative time for looking ahead. It's a perfect season to join a knitting class and turn locally grown yarn into a woolly masterpiece or buy your own warm coat from an alpaca farm.

Don't let the cold stop you from exploring. Don some gumboots and rug up for a walk in the bush. Fill your lungs with the crisp air. The earthy, eucalypt smell of the Otways in winter is truly intoxicating. And before you know it, the days are getting longer and there's a sniff of spring in the air.



Spring also brings the region's famous canola fields to life, with oceans of yellow flowers as far as the eye can see. Later in spring, local flower farms start picking roses and other blooms.

If all those bright, happy flowers aren't enough to lift your spirits, the first strawberries of the season start coming through in October at pick-yourown berry farms – a fun activity for people of all ages hitting peak season in mid-summer and running all the way through to March. Most of the berry farms in the Otways have onsite cafes and sell preserves and jams to take home, so it's a perfect day out.

Meanwhile at the vineyards, green shoots are sprouting on the vines, full or promise for another great vintage. And best of all, spring vegetables start arriving at farm gate stalls.


